The oral cavity can be difficult to examine thoroughly while Lucky Dog is awake. Consequently, signs of oral disease may not be detected until Lucky Dog has been anesthetised. Examples of problems frequently encountered include retained baby teeth, diseased teeth that need to be extracted, tumors and /or growths.

Factors that limit our ability to detect every dental problem your pet may have with just an oral exam include:

1. Lack of patient cooperation can impair visualization, especially of back teeth.
2. Many periodontal problems can be detected only by probing under the gum with an instrument.
3. Dental tartar can hide underlying cavities or fractures.

If further problems are detected while Lucky Dog is under anesthesia, how should they be handled?
